



19TH CONGRESS OF THE ASSOCIATION INTERNATIONALE POUR L'HISTOIRE DU VERRE

FIRST CIRCULAR AND CALL FOR PAPERS

The 19th Congress of the Association Internationale pour l'Histoire du Verre will take place in Slovenia in Piran, the historical town on the Northern Adriatic Sea, from Monday, 18th September through to Friday, 22nd September 2012. It will be organized by the University of Primorska, Science and Research Centre, Institute for Mediterranean Heritage in cooperation with the Association of Museums in Slovenia and ICOM Slovenia. The excursions and post-congress tour will be organized in cooperation with AIHV Italia and Museums in Croatia.

Special attention will be given to the glass from the prehistory till today on the area of SE Europe and the Balkans. Therefore relevant communications with focus on that will be particularly welcomed.

The Organizing Committee of the 19th Congress intends to combine a full programme of lectures and poster sessions with opportunities to visit museums and collections in Slovenia, Italy (Aquileia) and Croatia (Zagreb, Zadar, Split). During museum visits it will be possible to see also the material stored in depots. A two day excursion will be organized after the conference.

Excavators who do not wish to present an oral communication are particularly encouraged to present recent glass finds in posters.

Papers should have duration of 20 minutes. The languages of the congress are English, French, and German. There will be no simultaneous translation. The Congress themes are expected to focus on the history, archaeology, technology, archaeometry, and conservation of glass from the entire world.
